THE GIFT OF LITERACY

Dear Family in Christ,

The year 2017 is a special time for us as we celebrate 180 years of the Bible Society in Singapore. We have been blessed greatly by God over the past 180 years in carrying out the Bible Mission work in Singapore and beyond. This would not have been possible without the faithful partnership and support of many who have contributed towards the Bible Mission.

Living in wealthy Singapore, we are all the more aware that there are many who live in our surrounding region who may not have the same blessings as we enjoy. Access to education and the ability to go to school are not privileges that everyone has. To be able to read and write is a gift that we use daily, yet to many in our region, it remains a luxury.

Part of the Bible Mission work that the Bible Society of Singapore is involved in is with the establishing of literacy programmes in the region. Literacy is an essential aspect in helping people to engage with the Bible, as well as a skill set that will help them progress in life. This is a powerful gift, as it empowers people to learn, opens doors to new opportunities, and breaks the cycle of poverty.

One of the countries that the Bible Society is aiding is Myanmar, with a population of about 51.5 million people, but with about over 2 million people who are not able to read or write. The Bible Society of Singapore, in partnership with the Bible Society of Myanmar, is looking to establish 100 literacy classes in the Sgaw Karen, Asho Chin and Myanmar communities.

A pilot programme for literacy was successfully launched in Cambodia, and we are expecting it to have the same level of impact in Myanmar.

"As we cannot read, my husband and I feel blind to the world and we don't want our children to be like us," says Mrs Ptum Seng, a 36-year-old beneficiary of the Bible Literacy programme in Cambodia.


缅甸是圣经公会所支援的国家之一,人口大约5150万,但文盲却有200万。新加坡圣经公会正与缅甸圣经公会合作,预备在斯高克伦族、阿苏钦族及缅甸族这些族群里开办100个识字班。

我们在柬埔寨成功启动了识字班试点课程,我们期望它在缅甸也能有相同的影响力。36岁的Ptum Seng太太,是柬埔寨圣经识字班计划的受益者之一,她说:"我和先生都不识字,因此觉得看不清世界,我们不想孩子和我们一样。"

"我可以看到孩子们的阅读能力一天天地提高。他们每天都会抽出时间读圣经给我们听,所以我能听到上帝的话语。对我而言,这真是福气——这让我开心,我也感到平安喜乐。上帝对我们全家真好!"

我们相信,通过我们的识字班课程,我们可以在物质上和属灵上对缅甸这些族群产生深远影响。我们希望您能与我们合作,支持我们在本区域和更远地方的圣经宣教事工,并与我们一起为这些事工祷告,使上帝的话语成为世人永活的希望。
