Day 1 - Sun, 24 Nov SINGAPORE

Assemble at Changi Airport to begin your journey to Greece.

Departure Flight: TK55 SIN-IST 2335-0615 Check in starts from 8.30pm (Changi Airport, Terminal 1) Meals on board the plane

Day 2 – Mon, 25 Nov ATHENS

Transit in Istanbul for flight to Athens.

Transit Flight: TK1845 IST-ATH 0830-0900
Upon arrival, start with the Athens city tour. See Syntagma Square, the House of Parliament and the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, guarded by the Evzones in traditional costume. See the Athens Academy and the University. Stop at the Panathenaic Olympic Stadium (where the first Olympic Games of the modern era was held in 1896) and see the Temple of Zeus and Hadrian's Arch. Visit the world famous Acropolis* and see the Propylaea and Parthenon. Walk around Plaka, the old quarter. L/D

Day 3 – Tue, 26 Nov

KALAMBAKA (Check-out in the morning) See the Corinth Canal, which connects the Aegean and the Ionian Seas. Visit Ancient Corinth where you will see (Bema of Gallio, Temple of Apollo, Agora, the Erastus inscription and Perene Fountain). Return to Athens. Enroute, visit Monastery of Dafni and Kalambaka. B/L/D

Day 4 - Wed, 27 Nov

THESSALONIKI (Check-out in the morning) This morning, visit **Meteora*** and see the beautiful monasteries. You will also see architectural and historical treasures inside the monasteries. Drive to **Veria** (Biblical Berea) to visit the altar of St Paul, a traditional spot associated with St Paul before driving to **Thessaloniki** capital of the second Macedonian district. *B/L/D*

Day 5 - Thu, 28 Nov

KAVALA (Check-out in the morning)

Tour of the city and see the White Tower (symbol of Thessaloniki), Via Egnatia, Rotunda and visit the Church of St Dimitrios. Drive to Philippi and see the remains of the 2 Basilicas and St Paul's prison. Visit also Lydia's Baptismal site, the first woman convert. B/L/D

Day 6 – Fri, 29 Nov

CANAKKALE (Check-out in the morning)
Border Crossing to Turkey

See the Roman Aquaduct and St Paul's port before border crossing to Turkey. Change to Turkey coach and continue the drive to Canakkale. B/L/D

Day 7 - Sat, 30 Nov

IZMIR (Check out in the morning)
In the morning, drive to Izmir and stop
by the beautiful Pergamon*. Visit
Acropol and the highlights include Altar
of Zeus, Temple of Trojan and the
Theater Coming down the mountain,
we will stop by Asclepion. B/L/D

Day 8 - Sun, 1 Dec

KUSADASI (Check out in the morning)

Visit Church of Smyrna in Izmir and drive to the famous city of Ephesus*. Our tour will begin with the Bascilica of St John and the Temple of Artemis. Highlights include the Library of Celsus, the Temple of Hadrian, the Fountain of Trajan and Theatre. Stop by the House of the Virgin Mary (on top of Mt Coressos). She was believed to have spent her last years in this area. B/L/D

Day 9 - Mon, 2 Dec

PAMUKKALE (Check out in the morning)

After breakfast, stop at a **leather outlet** and enjoy a **Leather Fashion Show**. Drive to Pamukkale and stop at **Laodicea***, an important Christian centre in the Byzantine period. In the afternoon, visit **Hierapolis*** which was founded by the Pergamon King. Highlights include the Roman Baths, the Temple of Apollo and the Theater. *B/L/D*



Day 10 - Tue, 3 Dec

BURSA (Check out in the morning)

On the way to Bursa, stop at **Philadelphia** before driving to **Sardis**, one of the seven churches mentioned in Revelation. Highlights are a synagogue, a gymnasium, a Byzantine church and the Temple of Artemis. Next, stop at **Thyteria** to see the remains of the church. This was one of the principal towns where Christianity spread quickly. *B/L/D*

Day 11 – Wed, 4 Dec

ISTANBUL (Check out in the morning)

Drive to Iznik, formerlly known as **Nicea** Visit **St Sophia Church** which was built in the 4th century. Afternoon, we visit **Topkapi Palace**, home to the Sultans between the 15th and 19th centuries. *B/L/D*

Day 12 - Thu, 5 Dec

ISTANBUL (Check out in the morning)

Visit Hagia Sophia (also known as the Ayasofya Museum), built by Constantine the Great. Then we visit the Underground Basilica Cistern and Hippodrome of Constantinople. Take the Bosphorus River to enjoy the experience of cruising between 2 continents, Asia and Europe. Lastly, stop by the aromatic Spice Bazzar. B/L/D

Depart for international airport
Departure flight: TK54 IST-SIN 0155-1730
Arrive back in Singapore at 1750hrs.

- 4. Once the tour is confirm, the balance payment is required by 28 July 2019.
- 5. For late registration (3 months before departure date), do note there will be a late booking fee that will be advised to late applicants.
