A 365 DAY BIBLE READING PLAN

HOW TO USE THIS READING PLAN

- This Bible reading plan is designed to help you deepen your relationship with God through daily Bible reading and prayer.
- It is not dated, so there's no pressure to 'catch up' if you miss a day.
- You can start at any time during the year. The 12 listed sections have about 30 readings in them so they can be used month by month.
- Tick each reading off as you go to help keep track of your progress.
- If you're struggling to spend time with God and read your Bible daily, try some of the tips above each section.

HOW TO READ THE BIBLE

The Bible is spiritual food. It is of most benefit to us when we read it regularly. Thoughtful reading of the Bible with prayer will transform you. When you read the Bible, consider doing the following things:

TALK TO GOD

Thank God for the Bible. Ask God to help you understand what you're about to read.

READ AND LISTEN

Read the passage carefully and thoughtfully. Listen to what God may be saying to you through it.

THINK

Think about what you've read. Ask yourself these questions:

- What is the main point?
- What does the reading say about God? His character? His plans?
- What insight is there for me to apply to my life situation? Is there an example or a warning? Is God giving me a promise?
- How does God want me to respond in my thoughts, words or actions?

TALK TO GOD AGAIN

Turn things you've learned into prayers. Ask God for his help in applying what you've learned to your life. Pray for others.

TIP #1 • PUT IT INTO PRACTICE

Lessons from the Bible become that much more transforming when you live them. Don't just read the Bible, put what you learn into practice and see your life changed.
